Bryn Mawr Soap Company was founded out of an interest in natural soap because of it's effectiveness in combating dry skin, a nagging problem in northern climates.

Dismayed by the lack of an affordable, high quality, natural product, the founders opted to make their own soap and share it with friends and family. The response was enthusiastic, and as a result of high demand for Bryn Mawr Soap the business was established in January 2000.

The company is named after the Bryn Mawr (pronounced "brin-mar") neighborhood on the western edge of Minneapolis, Minnesota. Bryn Mawr is Welsh for "high hill", which reflects the parkland in and around this neighborhood. The founders have lived in Bryn Mawr for over fifteen years and have grown very attached to the local amenities (parks and merchants) and the people who volunteer their time and energy to keep this a great place to live. The name is a tribute to these people.

They can exacerbate skin problems because the oils' nutrients are removed while artificial dyes, scented and preservatives are added.

Bryn Mawr Soap is made from natural ingredients using a process that retains the glycerin and some of the oils. Our soaps will help rejuvenate your skin and leave your whole body feeling great!

- We don't use artificial fragrances, dyes or preservatives.
- We don't test on animals and use no animal products.
- Our soap is biodegradable.
- We use simplified packaging to minimize environmental impact.
- Our soap has a nice lather and lasts a long time.

ingredients

We use a single, proven, base recipe for all of our soaps—the only choice you need to make is scenting. Our base oils include olive oil, palm oil, coconut oil, cocoa butter and castor oil. Bars are mildly scented using natural essential oils and select botanicals.

Bars weigh approximately 4.25 ounces.

All of these soaps are great for the whole body.

cedar sage	You will love our wonderful blend of cedarwood and sage.
lavender	Our best selling soap! Lavender's unique blend of aromas is subtle and refreshing.
patchouli	Patchouli is the incense commonly used during the 1960s and 1970s. It has a distinct woody aroma.
peppermint	Peppermint is especially refreshing in the warm months to help you cool off. It's also a great wake-me-up!
spruce	Our spruce bar offers a nice "woody" aroma, especially popular among the men.
tangerine clove	This bar combines a lightly sweet citrus scent with a hint of the deeper, balancing clove. We also make this bar with oatmeal (oatmeal tangerine).
